This Trial is being held under Kennel club rules and regulations. Competitors and officials at gundogs Trial shall be subject to kennel club limited rules and regulations and in particular, the provision of field trial regulation

GENERAL

All dogs must be registered with the kennel club. Bitches in season will not be allowed on the ground. Anyone knowing their dogs have been in contact with infectious diseases should not attend the trial. All dogs should be vaccinated against Parvo Virus. There will be a break for lunch. All attending except officials, should provide their own lunch.
